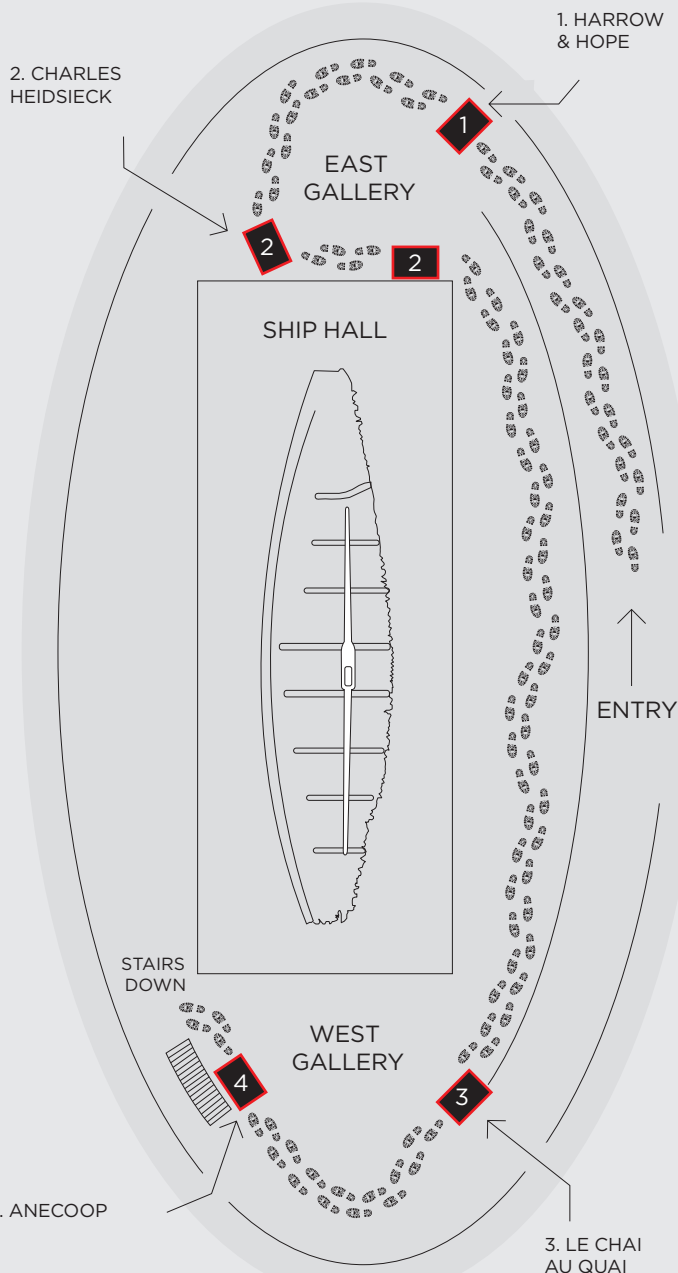

Continue through the galleries, discovering the ship's crew and the artefacts that were rescued from the wreckage before taking the lift up to the new world tasting area on the Upper Deck.

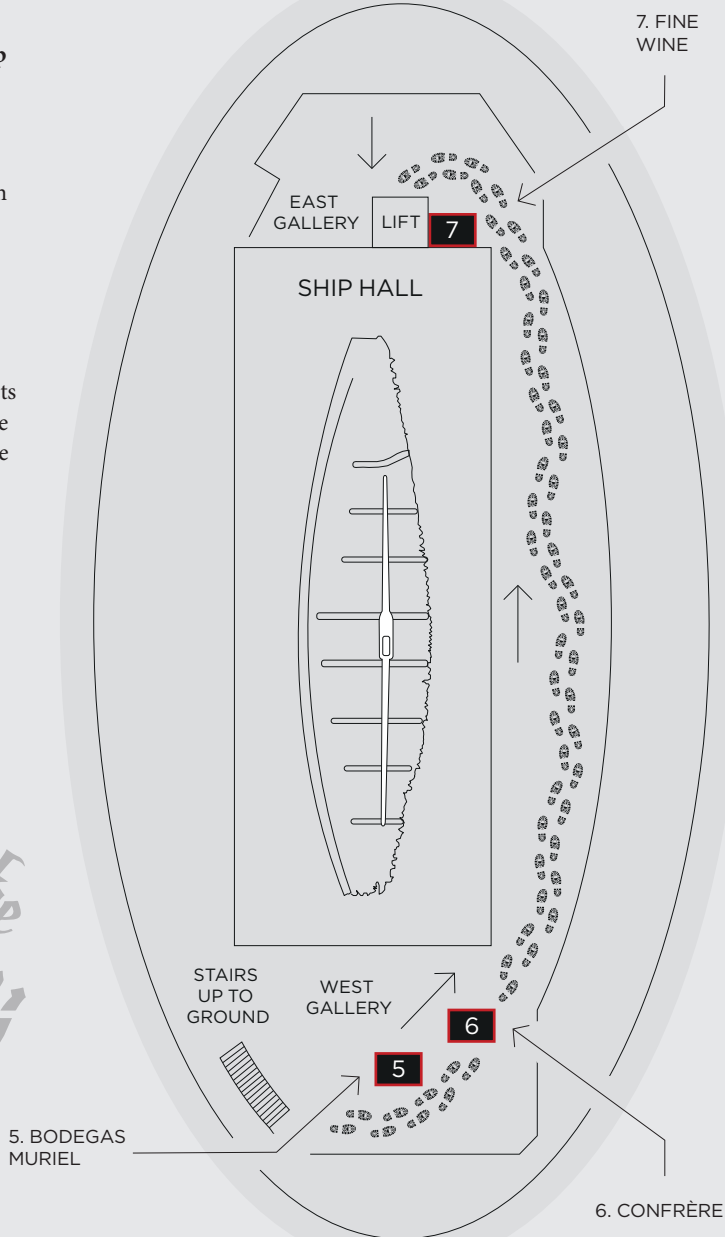

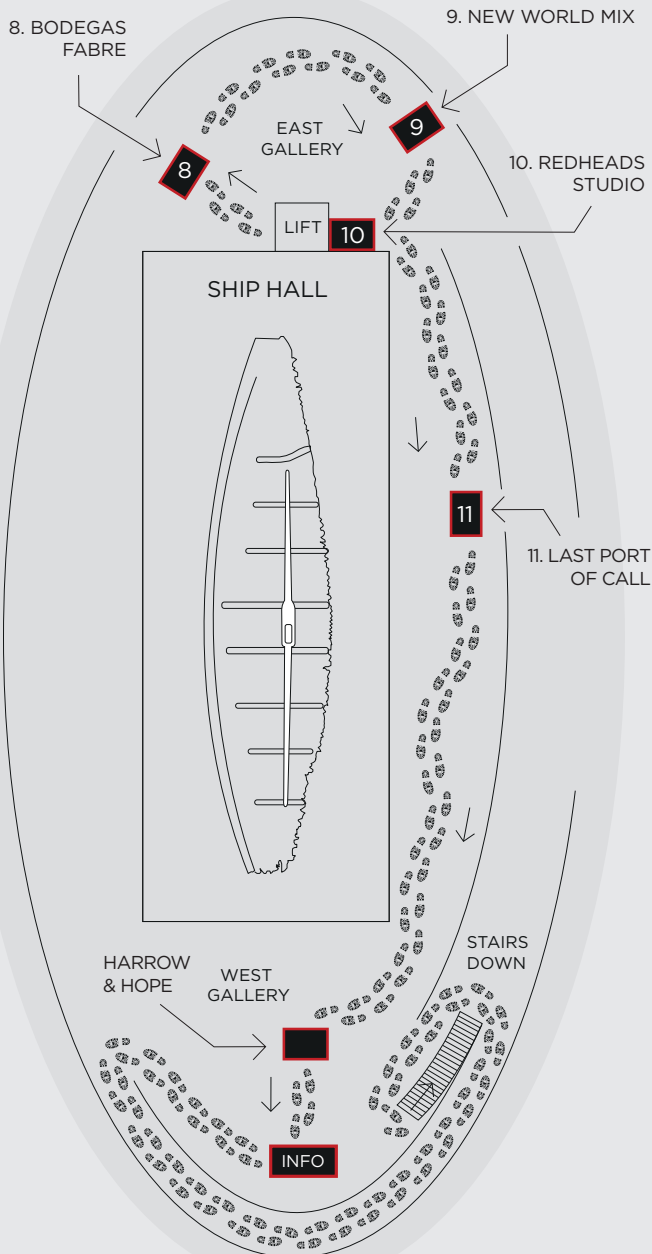
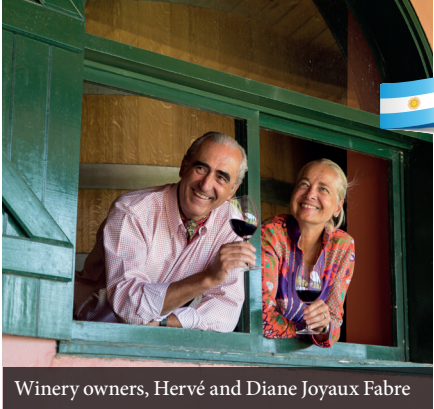
