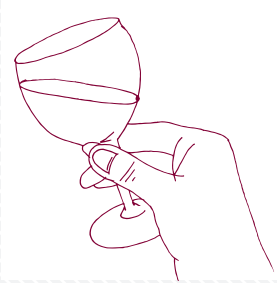

HOW TO TASTE WINE

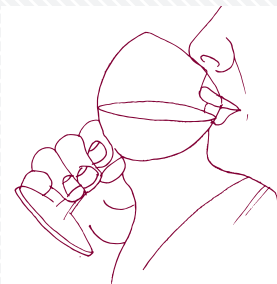
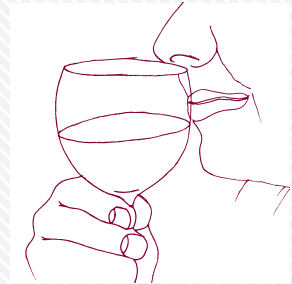


STEP 1. Look for colour and clarity

Hold your glass over a white background. It should look bright and inviting. For reds, a purple rim indicates youth; a garnet rim suggests age. Crisp young whites are usually pale. Older, richer or sweet whites have deeper colour.

STEP 2. Sniff the wine – twice

Sniff the wine before your swirl it. First impressions count – it should smell clean and attractive. Swirl the glass and sniff again. You'll notice more. What do the aromas remind you of? Fruits? Flowers? Spices? There are no right or wrong answers.



STEP 3. Give it a good rinse around

Take a mouthful and rinse it around. Note the initial sensation. Dry or sweet, firm or smooth, fruity or savoury, crisp or creamy? Are these elements nicely balanced? OK you can spit now (in the spittoons!). Does the flavour linger pleasantly? That's a sign of a good wine!

STEP 4. Note your findings

Writing a few words helps you recall which wines you loved most. You may even want to rate each wine on a scale of 1-10. If your unsure mark your first wine as your benchmark and go up and down from there as you continue to taste new wines.

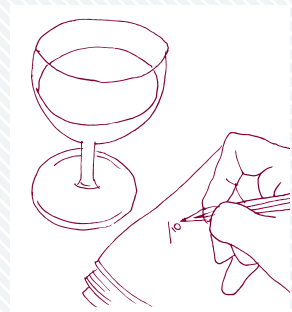

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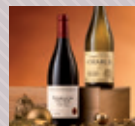

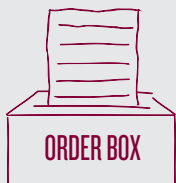
